

# 2022 MENTORSHIP GRANT PROGRAM



*Scientists-in-Training – Dermatology & Pathology Residents  
Dermatopathology Fellows – Junior Faculty*

**DESCRIPTION:** Grants up to \$3,000 each can be awarded to scientists-in-training, dermatology or pathology residents, dermatopathology fellows, or junior faculty to enable study with a hair research mentor. ***It is required that both Applicant and Mentor be an American Hair Research Society member to apply for the Mentorship Award. If you or your Mentor are not AHRS members, please apply for membership prior to submitting your Mentorship Award application. **PURPOSE:** To enable young physicians and scientists to acquire additional academic or research skills that will further their careers as leaders in hair research. ***Note that the focus of the program is on establishing a mentoring relationship, and not a specific research project.***

**TIME PERIOD:** March 2022 – February 2023

**ACCESS APPLICATION:** Application opens Thursday, July 29, 2021, via online portal: <http://registrationreports.com/grants/nahrs/mentorship2022/>. In the meantime, interested applicants should gather the required information described below.

**APPLICATION PROCESS:** Applications must include:

1. Completed application form accessed and submitted via online portal.
2. Budget outlining expenses to be incurred (up to a maximum of \$3,000).
3. Statement of purpose.
4. Curriculum vitae.
5. A letter from the proposed mentor to include a statement of willingness to provide the time necessary for this mentorship, any significant and pertinent details of the planned mentorship, and a specific mention of whether the time frame and budget are appropriate for the proposed mentorship.
6. A letter from the department chair attesting to the applicant's character and potential to benefit from the mentorship.

**POST-MENTORSHIP REPORT:** A one-page written report by the applicant summarizing the experience and what was learned is required after the mentorship has been completed, along with a photo of the mentee and mentor together (if possible) – for possible publication on the AHRS website.

**2022 APPLICATION DEADLINE:** Completed applications must be received **by November 30, 2021**, for awards to be announced in March the following year. **After we receive your application, we will contact you within 48 hours. If you have not heard from us within that time frame, please follow-up regarding your application.**

**COVID-19 VACCINATION:** COVID-19 vaccination requirements should align with the mentor's institution. It is the responsibility of the mentee to obtain this information from the mentor in advance of accepting this grant.
